4	Samuel Little	United States	1970–2005	60		Little was convicted of killing three women, but later investigations linked 31 other murders to him. He is now thought to be America's most prolific serial killer. He claimed he killed as many as 93 victims total, three above his initial confession of 90; the FBI later confirmed a total of 60 murders linked to Little. The investigations into his crimes are ongoing.[24][25]









